“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

Wisconsin Statutes re: immunizations

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

ENTRY FEE is \$45.00 Entries will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Match Committee.

DRAW for ENTRIES: will be held Wednesday March 10, 2010 at 7:00pm at Culver's of Brookfield, 21300 W Capitol Dr, Brookfield, WI to determine which dogs will participate. The public is invited. Entries will be NOTIFIED BY MAIL of their status as soon as possible after the draw. Non-participating alternates' fees will be returned within one week after the test.

Draw for tracks at 10:15am at Congdon Park parking lot.

DIRECTIONS to Draw for Tracks: From I-43, take Exit #21 ,Hwy 50 West to Wright St. Turn right and go to next stoplight at Hobbs Drive. Turn right to **Congdon Park** which is on the right, immediately past the shopping center.

LOCATION: The **Delavan Business Park** is located west of I-43 & north of Hwy 50, in Delavan, WI. It can be loosely defined as the area surrounding the blue Delavan water tower and bounded by Hobbs Dr, Hallberg St & Mound Rd. It is mostly composed of 1-2 story offices & light industry.
