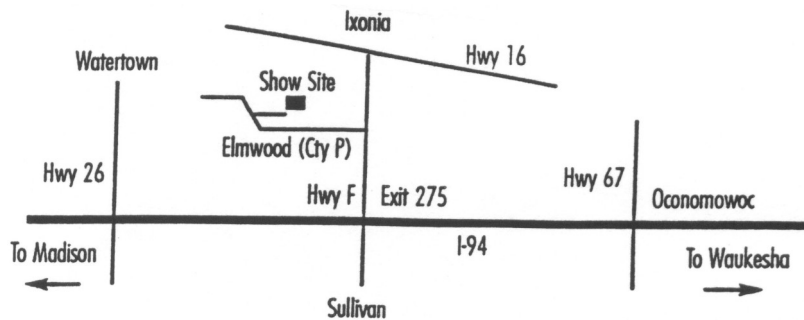

Judges are not required to wait for dogs and it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to have his/her dog ready at ringside without waiting to be called.
6. All trophies must be claimed at the trial. Unclaimed trophies will become the property of WWCDTC upon the completion of the Trial. Where there is a double entry of the same dog only the highest score will be eligible for special awards. Class awards will be given out at the conclusion of the judging of the class; all other awards will be given out after all judging has been completed.
